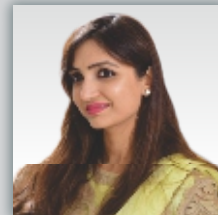

5. RPS is an integral part of Sanjay Rungta Group of Institutions (SRGI), that has more than 23 years of experience in the field of education.

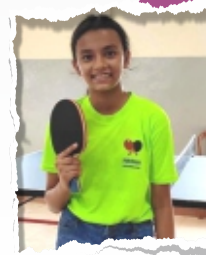
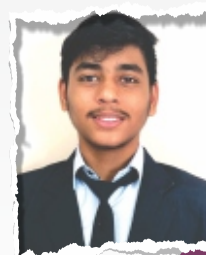


► ACHIEVEMENTS

We provide developmentally appropriate practices by teaching in ways that match the way students develop and learn. It provides daily experiences for students to discover that they are competent and capable learners.

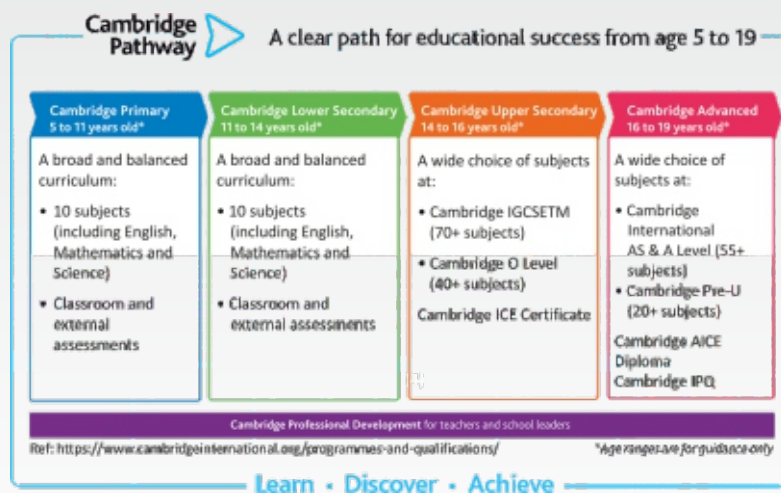

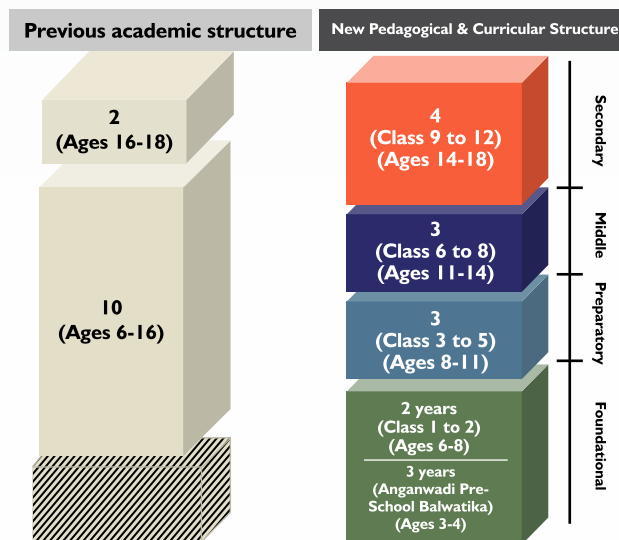

The Central Board of Secondary Education is a national level board of education in India for public and private schools, controlled and managed by the Government of India.

The New Education Policy is a comprehensive and all-encompassing policy that seeks to revamp the Indian Education System in its entirety. One of the most significant changes proposed by NEP is the switch from the 10+2 education structure to a new 5+3+3+4 education system.

Under the new system, students will spend five years in elementary school, three years in middle schools, three years in high school and four years in college. This will allow for a more well-rounded and holistic education, as students will be exposed to a broader range of activities.



▷ THE FACULTY

At RPS, you will meet teachers who think creatively, are passionate about teaching the students under their care. They are proactive, committed and dedicated. Learning at school is the outcome of strong partnership between the student and the teacher. The comfortable class size with an ideal teacher-pupil ratio helps the teacher to develop the latent talent in each student with individual attention. The faculty, chosen with utmost care brings depth of intellectual expertise and academic curiosity to the classroom. The faculty is easily accessible and available to guide and counsel the students as and when required.

▷ SUBJECTS TAUGHT

The subjects taught in normal curriculum are English, Hindi, Maths, Science, Social Science and Environmental Education at Primary, Middle and Secondary School level. We have Sanskrit or Hindi as the Second language at the Secondary level and Sanskrit language at the Middle level as the Third language. We have Foundation of Information Technology at Secondary level as an additional subject. At Sr. Secondary level we have both science and commerce stream.

▷ DAY BOARDING

Day boarding schools are a fantastic option for those parents who want extra edge for their child's academic domain.

Rungta Public School conducted a survey among parents which showed that many parents find it difficult to take children to different places in the city for tuition, music, games, arts, etc.

Day Boarding in our RPS was started with a view to cater to certain specific needs of the students who got enrolled to avail this facility. Class activities, homework, and other school assignments are taken care of by the teachers for the day boarders, and parents don't have to worry about it. Also, day boarders remain in school for extended hours.

Day boarders are served nutritious, healthy and balanced meals here in RPS.



▷ HOSTEL FACILITY

The hostels of Rungta Public School are defined as a second home for the ones who reside in the same.

We follow very strict yet friendly supervision of the boys and girls residing in the hostels. We ensure that the child can stay secure and peacefully. One male teacher and a female teacher are wardens of the boy's hostel and girl's hostel respectively. Both wardens reside in the hostels.

We provide hygienic and balanced diet for hostlers, which include milk, breakfast, lunch, evening snacks and dinner.

There are dedicated room and playground where the kids meet during their leisure and spend time playing outdoor or indoor games. This helps them fight boredom, homesickness, and other negative thoughts.

Student health and emergency administration is another important factor that tops the school's hostel facility list. Utmost care is taken to provide a positive environment and a home-like atmosphere during a child's stay in the hostel.



▷ SAFETY AND SECURITY

RPS is a safe place for children, where our responsibilities for safeguarding children are taken seriously. The school is surrounded by a high security boundary wall. Digital surveillance at all entrance and exits to monitor all activities, without interfering with the privacy of students.

▷ HOUSE SYSTEM

To promote team spirit, group loyalty and healthy competition among the students, the school will be divided into four houses after the names of great Indian personalities viz. Kalam, Raman, Tagore and Teresa.

Every student from class I onwards is placed in one of these houses. One boy and one girl known as the House Captain will head each house.

A member of the Staff assisted by several other teachers (tutors) will act as the House Warden. Points will be awarded to the students throughout the year for attainment in academics, co-curricular activities, games and sports. At the end of the year the house gaining the highest number of points will be awarded the Running Championship Trophy.



▷ PROMOTION CRITERIA

Promotion to the next class is granted to the pupil on the basis of his/her overall performance during the academic session. Hence the importance of regularity in attendance and work is desirable. The general criterion for promotion is that the student has grasped the subject matter of his/her present class adequately to follow the syllabus of the next higher class easily.

PLAY GROUP - UKG

For these classes no formal examinations are conducted. Promotion to next class is granted on the basis of his/her day to day class room and out-of class activities.

I-IX & XI

Promotion to the next class for all these classes is based on the whole year's performance i.e. progress achieved during the Weekly Tests, Periodic Tests, and Two Term Exams.

2. Xerox/Attested copy of the certificates should be enclosed with the filled in application form.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

1. Parents only should fill up the details and sign the form. In case this form is filled in by the guardian, then it should be stated clearly.
2. At the time of admission for classes PLAY GROUP - the original Birth Certificate is required and in case of admissions from Class II onwards, Transfer Certificate in original should be produced. No admission will be complete and validated till the above documents are submitted.
3. Parents should take care to note that the name and date of birth as given in the application should tally with the name and correct spellings as given in the original Birth Certificate or Transfer Certificate.
4. Even if the admission fee is accepted, the admission shall remain only provisional until all the documents are checked and found correct by the school authorities.

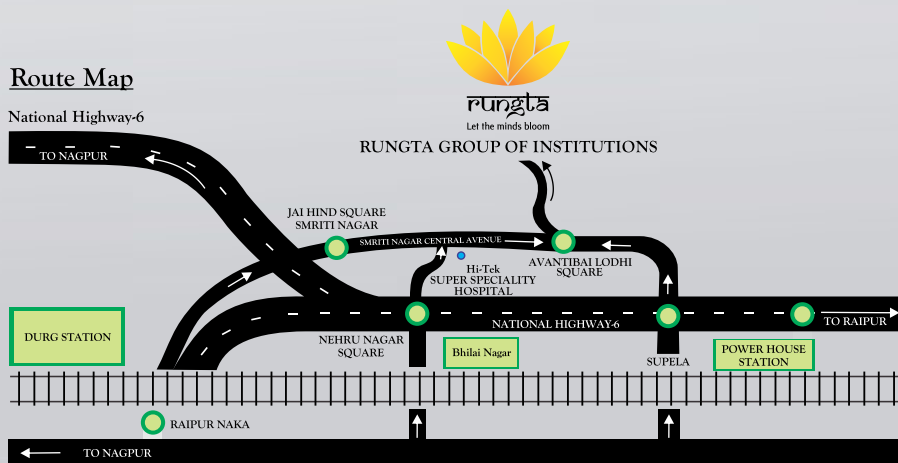
